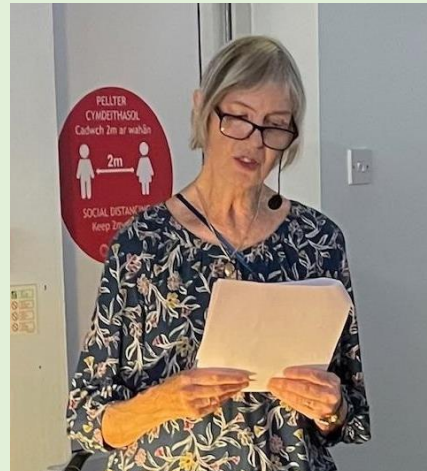
Lois Jones told us about Ty Mawr Wybrant and the History of Bishop William Morgan translating the Bible into Welsh.
